Venue: Royal British Legion Club, Priory Lane, Bungay

Time of event – 11.00 until 2.00pm

Raffle tickets to be sold at the event for £2 Adult and £1 children 12 and under

The event is run as a dual event

Amateur Bakers (open to the public)

There will be 8 savoury categories in which to enter – Any person can enter any number of the categories. The categories are:

1. Sausage rolls
2. Pies and Pasties
3. Scones (savoury)
4. Pizza
5. Quiche
6. Cheese Straws
7. Bread Products
8. Wild Card (for any other type of savoury not in the other categories).

Each entrant must produce two exact batches of the product. One batch will be for free tasting by the general public and judges and the second batch will be raffled off at the end of the event.

NOTE: All baking to be completed at home prior to the event – there are no cooking facilities on site on the day.

The top 3 entrants in each category will receive a prize certificate.

Judges will be invited local dignitaries and a member of the Falcon Meadow Trust

Local Businesses

Local businesses can provide a stall for free tasters of their goods, there will however be no prize certificates for this section. There are 2 options

- a) provide free tasters only and promote goods with discount vouchers and/or advertise the business or
- b) provide free tasters and sell the goods providing a donation is made to the event.

In either option it is expected that some of the goods are supplied as a raffle prize.

All the public will use their entry / raffle ticket for the raffle prize of the donated products.

Under no circumstances will any competition entrants or commercial entrants be allowed to provide drinks, and no public entrants to the venue be allowed 'doggie bags'.
